secular cantata composed by George Frideric Handel to a libretto by Ambrose Philips, of which the first line, Eternal source of light divine, provides an alternative title for the work. It was probably composed during January 1713 for a performance on 6 February 1713 (which did not occur). Other catalogues of Handel's music have referred to the work as HG xlviA; and HHA
